III. Needs Development Workshop

Franco Saraceno, Gannett Fleming, detailed the needs development process planned for the workshop, including a review of E+C model results and discussion of appropriate solutions to system deficiencies individually for each transportation planning area. Mr. Saraceno presented a series of plots depicting the model results in terms of volume to capacity ratios (highway level of service) and travel patterns at a resolution of 16 districts within the County. The plots were utilized by the Steering Committee to develop needed transportation improvements, which will be presented back to the Steering Committee at the November meeting.
